Nexstream Secures \$113.5 Million to Expand Fiber Broadband Across Rural Texas

Fredericksburg, TX – March 4, 2025 – Nexstream, a Texas-based broadband provider rooted in the Hill Country, has secured a total of \$113.5 million in funding through the Texas Broadband Development Office’s BOOT II grant program. The funding will support the construction of over 1,700 miles of fiber infrastructure, bringing high-speed, reliable Internet to more than 7,700 homes, businesses, and community spaces across Edwards and Burleson counties.

This investment marks a significant step in closing the digital divide in rural Texas, enabling residents and businesses to access critical online resources for education, healthcare, and economic growth.

Breaking Ground in Edwards and Burleson Counties

The BOOT II funding is divided between two key rural regions:

- Edwards County: \$77.5 million to deploy more than 1,100 miles of fiber to connect over 2,700 locations.
- Burleson County: \$36 million to deploy nearly 600 miles of fiber to connect over 5,000 locations.



These projects will transform connectivity for thousands of Texans in traditionally underserved areas, where limited broadband access has long been a barrier to opportunity.
