Nexstream to Lead \$77.5M Broadband Expansion in Texas with BOOT II Grant

Fredericksburg, TX – February 5, 2025 – Nexstream, a leader in bridging the digital divide, is proud to announce its selection as a recipient of the Texas Broadband Development Office’s (BDO) BOOT II (Bringing Online Opportunities to Texas) grant. This award underscores Nexstream’s commitment to delivering high-speed, reliable Internet to underserved communities throughout Texas and beyond, leveraging innovative technology and local investment.

As the grant recipient, Nexstream will lead the deployment of broadband infrastructure in Edwards County. The grant award totals \$77.5 million and will serve 2,724 locations across the county. This project will require the construction of over 1100 miles of fiber, bringing high-speed Internet to rural communities.
